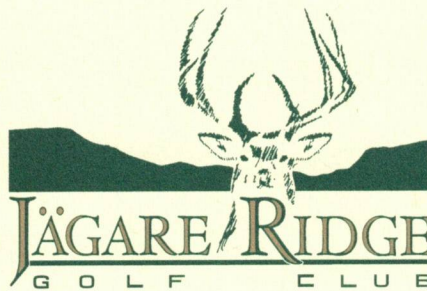

Re: Jagare Ridge Subdivision Maintenance

We would like to take this opportunity to provide you with an update on our subdivision maintenance schedule. I will briefly outline our current maintenance schedule, and then provide you with our action plan moving forward.

Currently, we mow the areas around the stormwater ponds, and at the developer's request, the City-owned parks and pathways once a week; we have decided to increase this to twice a week during the growing season to better target weed growth in these areas. We will also be conducting frequent weed picking (twice per month) to keep those areas looking nice. In addition, we are going to add more mulch to some of the shrub beds alongside the pathways. We will continue to use the weed whip alongside the fence, and will blow off any grass on the workout area.

The City of Edmonton does not allow us to use herbicides on non-noxious weeds such as dandelions so frequent mowing and weed picking are our best options.

Since we are allowed to use approved weed control products on golf course property we will continue to address the areas around the stormwater ponds to keep the dandelions at bay. We treated the areas around the stormwater ponds today which should help keep the dandelions at bay.

With respect to garbage collection, we empty out the community garbage bins every two weeks or whenever they are half full (whichever occurs first). We also endeavor to pick up garbage whenever our crews are out, and will continue to do so.

Construction activity can pose some disruption to homeowners, and we will continue to monitor this; unfortunately it is a reality of living in a new and developing community. We would also kindly ask that homeowners address any areas that may have been impacted by their landscaping projects.

Our goal is to provide a high quality landscaping and maintenance service that complies with local regulations, and enhances the Jagare Ridge Community that you call home.
